Jonathan Read, PhD, is a lecturer in infectious disease epidemiology at the Department of Epidemiology & Population Health, Institute of Infection and Global Health, and is a affiliated with National Center for Zoonosis Research, both at the University of Liverpool. He received his BSc in Biology from the University of York in 1991, and his PhD in Ecology from the University of Stirling, UK, in 1996. He was a postdoctoral researcher at the Macaulay Land Use Research Institute, the University of Leicester, and the University of Cambridge between 1997 and 2000, and at the Mathematics Institute, University of Warwick from 2001 to 2007, before joining Liverpool in 2007. His research is focused on understanding the transmission dynamics of respiratory pathogens through the quantification of social contact patterns, mathematical modelling, and epidemiological field studies in USA, China, Malawi and Vietnam.
